> Joe Root opens for the summer style team with a finely balanced collection of refined yet relaxed kit





here's a feeling of optimism in the air right now, as summer's longer days and warmer weather set the tone for a languid succession of out-of-office escapes, social gatherings and sporting spectaculars over the coming months.
